Composer of the Month

Gordon Jacob

b. July 5, 1895

d. June 8, 1984

English composer and teacher, author of four

books and many articles about music. His output includes more than 700 original compositions or arrangements of existing music. Jacob served in WWI and was taken prisoner in 1917. He studied



a harmony textbook in the prison camp library and began composing, writing for an orchestra of his fellow prisoners with assorted instruments. His best known works for flute are the Concerto for Flute and Strings (1952) and The Pied Piper (1958), an unaccompanied work in two movements: "The Spell" (solo flute) and "March to the River Weser" (solo piccolo).
